Sub: Criteria for exclusion of persons within the Backward Classes as Creamy Layer.

The National Commission for Backward Classes (herein after called the Commission) has been constituted under Article 338B of the Constitution of India. It shall be the duty of the Commission to investigate and monitor all matters relating to the safeguard provided for the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes under any other law for the time being in force or under any order to the Government and to evaluate the working of such safeguard.

2. A representation dated 28.11.2021 from Shri Vishvakarma Sabha, Barara (Ambala)-133201, Haryana has been received in the Commission on the above mentioned subject (Copy enclosed). In this regard, Dr. Bhagwan Lal Sahni, Hon'ble Chairman, National Commission for Backward Classes, has fixed a Full Commission Hearing on 03-01-2022 at 02:00 PM in the Chamber of Hon'ble Chairman, First Floor, Trikoot-I, Bhikaji Cama Place, New Delhi-110066 for investigation/inquiry/action to be taken in the matter.


3. Accordingly, you are requested to appear in person for hearing before the Hon'ble Commission on the above scheduled date and time along with full facts and all relevant

original records/ documents pertaining to the case. It is requested to bring Stamp Paper (Rs. 10) with you to furnish reply on affidavit to the Commission as per requirement. The petitioner is advised to be present in the hearing.

4. Please take notice that in case you fail to attend the Hearing, the Commission is its liberty to exercise the powers of Civil Court under clause (8) of article 338 B of the Constitution of India for enforcing your attendance before the Commission.
